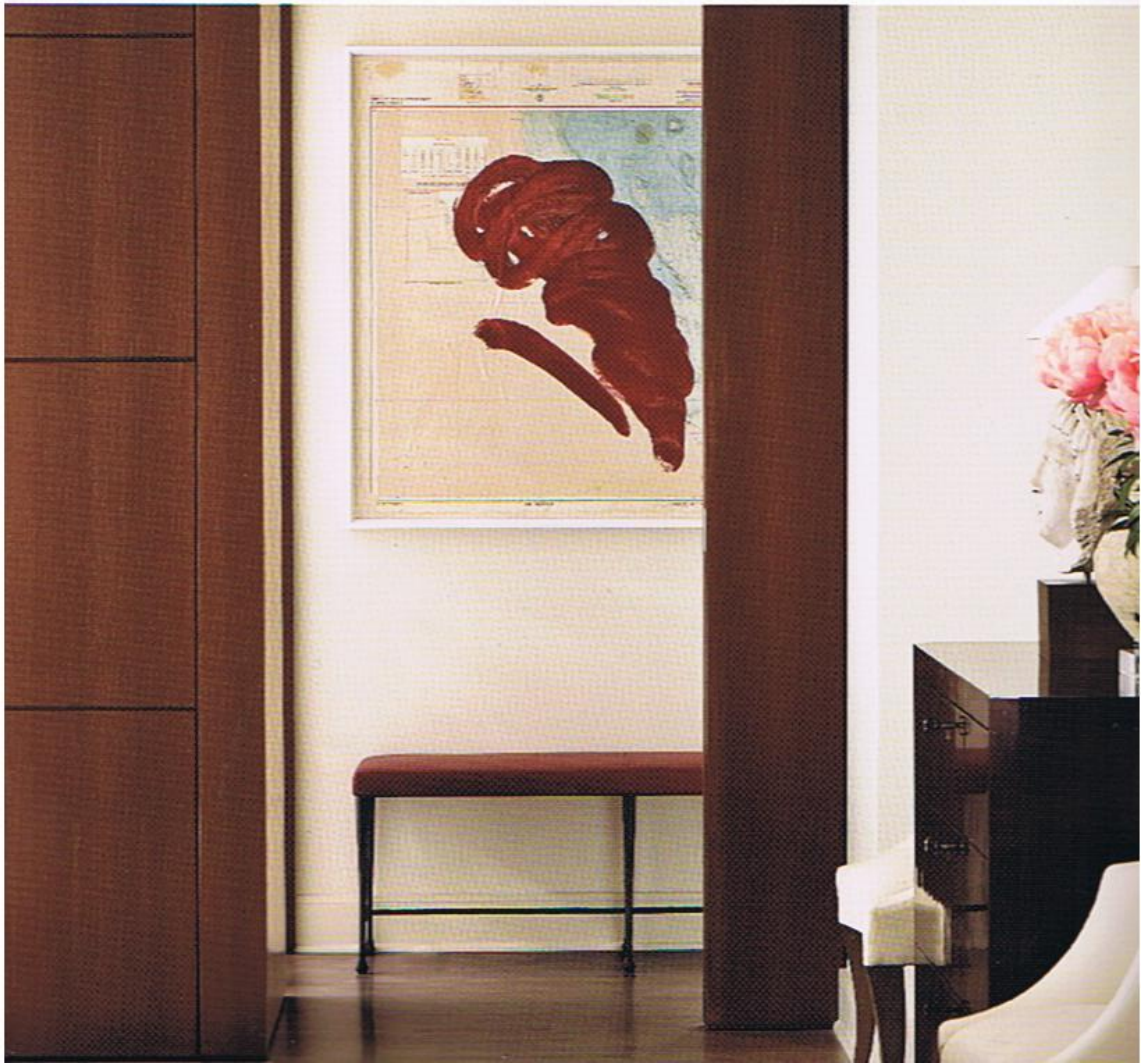

▣ Inspired by nature, the Sculptured Contour Chair from Vladimir Kagan originally made its debut in 1953. "The chair's sculpted walnut frame draws inspiration from the natural growth of trees," Kagan says. "As a child, I spent hours drawing trees and marveled at their natural definition of strength and flexibility." The hand-rubbed walnut wood frame and buttery leather cushioning, also available in white, comes complete with a matching ottoman. The original chair is in the permanent collection of the Museum of Fine Arts, Boston.



"This handcrafted chair conforms to the contours of the body and is meticulously constructed of sculpted wood. I see it as both a sculptural form and work of art, and have used it in a living room next to an occasional table, creating an artful setting."
