



FRITZ NAGEL AND CÈSAR STOFFI FOR BMF MODULAR CANDLEHOLDERS: "ORION"

Founded in 1902 as a modest metal-working manufactory in Bavaria, Germany, Bayerische Metall Fabrik (BMF) became an international manufacturer of high quality and luxury design elements for the home. Created by BMF designers Nagel and Stoffi in the 1960s, this modular assemblage of candleholders represents a particularly ingenious offering; each holder interlocks with others to make a multiplicity of forms, so the owner of the piece helps shape the final design. Its Brutalist statement emerges from the turned-metal intricacy of its spindled cylinders, and from the sheer mass of the sculptural result.
